Oggetto (Subj): COLOMBIA - INDONESIA.

Testo (Text):

Dear sirs,

please be informed that this mrcc have received the following alert:

1. **COLOMBIA:** On 12 February, two perpetrators attempted to board the anchored Japan-flagged bulk carrier FRONTIER SKY in the Puerto Bolivar Anchorage, near position 12:17N – 072:01W. The perpetrators approached the vessel in a small boat and attempted to board using a rope attached to a hook. A duty crewman observed the attempt and notified the bridge. The alarm was raised and the ship's horn sounded. Hearing the alarm, the perpetrators aborted their attempted boarding and moved away. The master reported the incident to Puerto Bolivar marine operations. A patrol boat responded and searched the waters around the bulk carrier.
2. **INDONESIA:** On 15 February at 0510 local time, two robbers armed with knives boarded an underway Liberia-flagged bulk carrier in the eastbound lane of the Singapore Strait Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS), near position 01:15N – 104:12E, northeast of Batam Island. The duty crew spotted the robbers in the engine room. The alarm was raised and the crew mustered. A search of the vessel found that engine stores had been stolen. The master reported all crew members safe.
3. On 15 February at 0415 local time, five perpetrators armed with knives boarded an underway Pakistan-flagged bulk carrier in the eastbound lane of the Singapore Strait TSS, near position 01:16N – 104:10E, northeast of Batam Island. The ship's master reported that all crew were safe, and that nothing was reported stolen. The vessel did not require any assistance, and continued its transit to China.
